## Examples of Clinician Learning Goals

CPD PLAN FOR NEXT YEAR		
Set 3 to 5 learning goals for next year and describe how these goals relate to your role and scope of practice.		
	Learning Goal	Relationship to your role and scope of practice
1.	Improve knowledge of insulin pump therapy by attending conferences or workshops on this aspect of diabetes education and making contact with an experienced CDE in this field during 2015.	In 2015-16 I will volunteer at camps for children with type1 diabetes. I'm expected to provide high quality care to children using insulin pumps.
2.	Improve quantitative research skills by attending a research skills workshop in 2015 and applying these skills to QI projects that I am working on.	At work I'm expected to analyse statistical data from my QI projects.
3.	Maintain skills in health coaching by continuing to read up to date literature in this area and attend workshops/webinars/seminars on this topic in 2015.	I have taken a break from phone coaching until 2016, but I want to continue providing high quality self management support.

	Learning Goal	Relationship to your role and scope of practice
1.	Present visual information more concisely by updating my skills in this area through online training in 2015.	I plan to submit an abstract for a poster presentation in 2015 and I will need more advanced computer skills to design the poster.
2.	Adapt content of lectures to medical and pharmacy students to the feedback previously provided by collating evaluation responses and updating content through research of best practice guidelines before the end of 2015.	I give three lectures to university students each year, and although participants completed evaluation surveys this year, I have not updated the lecture format since 2011.
3.	Support senior staff to work more autonomously in 2015 by improving my management and support skills through attending a management workshop and forming a mentoring partnership with a colleague with similar team structure.	I lead a team of six team members, and I need to balance the needs of the department with the greater clinic

## Examples of 'Researcher Learning Goals'

Set 3 to 5 learning goals for next year and describe how these goals relate to your role and scope of practice.		
	Learning Goal	Relationship to your role and scope of practice
1.	Continue to develop my skills as a researcher by regular meetings with my research team and supervisor to complete my research project on the patient experience of hypoglycaemia within the next 12 months.	I'm the lead researcher and I need to prepare the final report to secure ongoing funding for the next phase of this project.
2.	Improve my critical thinking skills by sourcing and reading tools and guidelines for reviewing publications and abstracts within the next 3 months to prepare for my new role in 2015.	In 2015, I have committed to review abstracts for an international conference, with a very high standard of peer review expected.
3.	Refine my media skills by attending a media workshop within the next 6 months.	I have agreed to participate in two radio interviews. I'm expected to stay focussed and answer impromptu questions with confidence.
