

ADEA Diabetes Research Foundation Commitment to management of duality and conflict of interest

The Australian Diabetes Educators Association (ADEA), its Research Foundation and Research Council manage duality and potential conflict of interest in accordance with the <u>ADEA Conflict of Interest Policy 2014</u>.

This means that:

- 1. The ADEA COI Disclosure Form is customised for Council Members and Reviewers
- 2. The Council maintains, with the support of the Executive, a Register of COIs for Council Members and for Reviewers, detailing the name of the person with the COI, the date it was reported, the nature of COI, action taken to manage the conflict and the outcome
- COI policy information is included in relevant Foundation documentation including guidelines for applicants and reviewers.
- 4. COIs are declared and managed in Council meetings, including business conducted outside meetings, for example via email where appropriate
- 5. Council Members are excluded from eligibility to receive grant funding or other material benefit from the Foundation.
