Participants are encouraged to come with an idea and leave with a beginning research protocol that can be polished after the workshop and submitted as a key component for the Research Grants or Research Fellowship Program, funded by the ADEA Diabetes Research Foundation.

Participants are asked to come prepared with an idea for a research project.

It does not need to be a final aim or method.

Key issues to think about are:

- Why am I interested in the topic?
- Who else might be interested in the topic?
- What is already known about the topic?
- How could I conduct a study about the topic?
- When could I do the study?
- What resources and support do I have to conduct the study?

These are key aspects of a research protocol.
