

Research Title: Nox 1/4 inhibition to treat kidney disease in type 1 diabetes

This study may be suitable for you if all of the following apply:

- You have type 1 diabetes
- You are 18 to 70 years old
- You have albumin (protein) in the urine
- Your HbA1c is <10%.

About this study:

This study will test whether a new tablet can help to treat diabetic kidney disease. The study will last for 56 weeks, and participants will be allocated to receive either the new tablet or placebo. There will be 10 study visits.
